<p>Youth Boat Building Class</p>  <p>CHICAGO MARITIME Arts Center</p>	<p>Offered in partnership with Chicago Maritime Arts Center and Southern Shore Yacht Club, this class engages student in actually building a Bevin's Skiff (rowboat) which they will launch at the end of the session and have an opportunity to use.</p> <p>Learn teamwork, basic wood-working skills and STEM skills used not only in boat building, but everyday life. Discover the career opportunities available in such fields as carpentry, construction, marine systems (mechanical, electrical, plumbing), marine transportation, recreational boating and marine ecology as well as many others!</p> <p>NOTE: This class is held at Southern Shore Yacht Club in Jackson Park Inner Harbor (on west side of Lake Shore Drive) not at JPYC.
